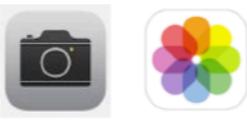

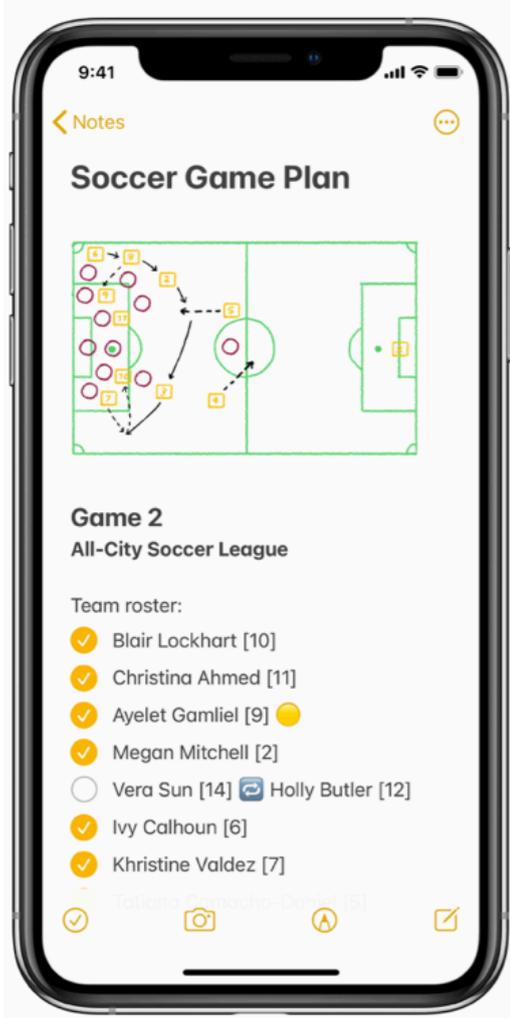

Notes



Use the Notes app to jot down quick thoughts or organize detailed information with checklists, images, web links, scanned documents, handwritten notes, and sketches. **1**



1. Take notes on your iPhone

Create and format a new note

Ask Siri: e.g. “Create a new note” or

- Tap , then enter your text. To change the formatting, tap **Aa**. You can apply a heading style, bold or italic font, a bulleted or numbered list, and more. To save the note, tap Done.

Tip: To choose a default style for the first line in all new notes, go to Settings>Notes>New Notes Start With.

Add a checklist: Tap , then enter text to add an item, then tap Return for the next item.

Add or edit a table: Tap , tap a cell, then enter your text. To add or delete a row or column, tap the selection handle for that row or column, then choose to add or delete.

Draw or write in Notes: Tap , then draw or write with your finger or Apple pencil. Use the

Markup tools to change colors or tools. **2**

Add attachments to Notes

You can attach photos, videos, and scanned documents. You can even add info from other apps—maps, links, documents, and more.

- In a note, tap  and choose to add a Photo or Video from your Photos Library, take a photo or video, or Scan Documents **3** into your note.

See the Notes chapter in the iPhone User Guide to learn how to work with folders, sort and pin your notes **4**, and how to search for typed and handwritten text in your notes.

Recommended Notes settings (See Settings>Notes)

- Only use Notes in iCloud (not in your mail accounts)
- Your default account should be iCloud
- “On My iPhone Account” should be OFF.
- Sort Notes By & New Notes Start With should both be by Title.
