

Multitasking

New Multitasking menu

Tap to reveal a new Multitasking menu that lets you create a full screen, Slide Over, Split View, and in some instances, a center window, so you can work on multiple apps at once.




Focus

Match your devices to your mindset

Focus helps you stay in the moment when you need to concentrate or step away. Choose from a list of Focus options or create your own to allow only the notifications you want — you can get work done while you're in the zone or enjoy a distraction-free dinner.

Signal your status

Stepping away is easier if others know you're busy. So when you're using Focus, your status will be automatically displayed in Messages and shared with other communication apps you allow. And for truly urgent messages, there's still a way for people to notify you.




Matching Home Screen pages with Focus

Dedicate a page on your Home Screen to a specific Focus and organize your apps and widgets in a way that reduces temptation by making only related apps visible. The page appears when you're in a Focus and hides everything else.





Use Focus on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch

With iOS 15 and iPadOS 15, Focus lets you stay in the moment when you need to concentrate or step away from your device. You can customize Focus settings and choose when you want to receive alerts and notifications, while letting other people and apps know when you're busy.

Turn on Focus

1. Go to Settings > Focus.
2. Tap a provided Focus option — like Do Not Disturb, Personal, or Sleep — then turn on the Focus.
3. After you choose a Focus, select options like Allowed Notifications, Time Sensitive Notifications, and Focus Status.

When you set up a Focus, you can select Allowed Notifications from people and apps. You can also enable



people and apps. You can also enable Time Sensitive notifications from apps, which allows apps not in your allowed list to send notifications marked as Time Sensitive.

You can also turn on Focus from Control Center. Just [open Control Center on your iPhone or iPod touch](#), or on your [iPad](#), touch and hold Focus, then select the Focus you want to turn on.

Turning a Focus on for this device will also turn it on for your other devices.


When you use Focus on one device, the setting is automatically applied across your Apple devices that are signed in with the same Apple ID.

When you set a Focus, the icon appears in the status bar and on your Lock Screen, and your status is automatically displayed in the Messages app. When people try to send you a message, they'll see that you've silenced notifications, but they can still notify you if it's urgent.

When you use Focus on one device, the setting is automatically applied across your Apple devices that are signed in with the same Apple ID.

Set up a custom Focus

If you want to concentrate on an activity that's different from any of the provided Focus options, you can create a Custom Focus. Here's how:



1. Go to Settings > Focus.
2. Tap the Add button **+**, then tap Custom or browse additional options.
3. Enter a name for your Focus.
4. Choose a color and an icon to represent your Focus, then tap Next.
5. Customize the options for your Focus.





After you set up Focus, you can silence notifications or allow only notifications from the people and apps that match your Focus. You can also customize a Home Screen page that has only apps related to your Focus and make that page the only one accessible during the time you have the Focus enabled. Here's how:

1. Go to Settings > Focus.
2. Select the Focus that you want to customize, then tap Home Screen.
3. Turn on Custom Pages, then select the Home Screen pages you want to use during this Focus.
4. Tap Done.


From here, you can also turn on Hide Notification Badges, which hides notifications on your Home Screen apps.



3. Select **Custom** to create a new Focus.
4. Give your custom Focus a name and choose a colour/emoji/icon to make it recognizable, then tap **Next**.



What is shared?
Apps only know that you have notifications silenced. Apps don't know which Focus you have on, so the name is never shared, but they can control how Focus status is shown.
